Executive Summary Lasbela-Hub Community Outreach Workshop

The Lasbela-Hub Community Outreach Workshop was the third stakeholders’ dialogue under the consultation process spreading over nine workshops involving all stakeholders for creating economic literacy and local ownership of the economic reforms under the Framework for Economic Growth of Pakistan formulated by the Planning Commission and approved by the National Economic Council. It was organized by the Lasbela University of Agriculture, Water and Marine Sciences (LUAWMS) in collaboration with the Planning Commission of Pakistan, the Governance Institutes Network International (GINI) and DFID on 24th September, 2011 as per agenda at **Annex-I**. The workshop was attended by over 160 participants as per details at **Annex-II**. Selected press clippings of local print media covering the stakeholders’ dialogue at Uthal/Lasbela are attached separately.

Inaugural Session

Ms. Saira Bano, Chairperson, English Department, LUAWMS welcomed the participants. She gave a brief overview of various programs/courses being run at LUAWMS.

Brig. Muhammad Saleem (Retd), Consultant GINI thanked LUAWMS for hosting the workshop. He briefed the participants about the purpose/objectives of the consultation process on Framework of Economic Growth of Pakistan developed by the Planning Commission spreading over nine workshops with DFID support. He underlined the critical importance of economic reform and requested the participants to be objective in their views/remarks in finding solutions to the problems of economic growth of Pakistan, instead of indulging in blame game.

Dr. Kaiser Bengali in his opening remarks highlighted the importance of the selected themes of economic growth for the workshop and hoped that the stakeholders’ dialogue would help in finding way forward in these areas.

The key note speech was delivered by Dr. Nadeem-ul-Haq Deputy Chairman Planning Commission of Pakistan, through his 45 minutes video address covering the root causes of current dismal economic picture of Pakistan, its regional comparison and the salient features of the Framework for Economic Growth of Pakistan for achieving a sustained growth rate of 7% per annum for the next 20 to 25 years.

Mr. Shahid Sattar, Member Energy, Planning Commission of Pakistan made a power-point presentation on energy. He explained the factors leading to current energy crisis including loss of 60% of installed capacity due to lack of maintenance of public sector generation facilities, huge circular debt in the energy sector, absence of expert managers leading to inefficiency in PSEs. He said that the Government would bring in best experts managers for public organizations by outsourcing their recruitment to a private agency under transparent

and accountable mechanism. On the gas shortages, he highlighted that since CNG is mostly used in cars and their owners by any definition are rich, hence they do not qualify for any subsidy. Therefore the CNG price would be brought at par with petrol in next 2 years in order to reduce users' reliance on CNG and for meeting the gas shortfall for power generation/industrial use.

Stakeholders' Dialogue

The stakeholders' dialogue was conducted with brief video clips on the growth themes, followed by open discussion as given in the agenda. As a result of stakeholders' dialogue during the workshop, following key points of both consensus and contention emerged covering a series of key areas for follow-up implementation of the Framework for Economic Growth of Pakistan formulated by the Planning Commission:

1. Foreign investments have virtually come to a halt due to security and governance issues, weak rule of law, less industrial growth and less profit in Pakistan.
2. Disconnect between sustainable growth and adhocism of policies must be removed for economic stability
3. Thar coal reserves should be used for meeting energy requirement. Alternate energy generation sources like solar, wind, use of agricultural products should be looked into through proper research. The government's shift in the CNG policy being propagated needs to be properly analyzed / researched to assess the size of private investments/employment which would be affected and its fallout on government credibility for encouraging private investments/entrepreneurship under the new growth framework.
4. Monopolies and utilities can best be run by public sector with service delivery orientation. Public Sector Management should be improved through hiring of professional managers from open job markets but only under legally defined transparent recruitment mechanism. Public-private partnership under well-defined terms & conditions would help in improving service delivery.
5. No theoretical solution for long term growth would be effective. Supportive role of common citizen in approaching and implementing the best practices to promote economic growth would be necessary. Civil society has to build demand for better governance, create pressure groups in general public and students and academia and play positive role in making opinion for mind-set change.
6. Agricultural sector must also receive due focus under the NGF for growth and food security. Livestock investment is less and in rural areas agriculture production is ignored in policy formulation. Our exports of meat, milk and fruits are going down for the last decade which needs to be properly examined and necessary measures taken.
7. Fair and friendly bye-laws and regulations are necessary to encourage private entrepreneurship. Allowing higher profits with lesser taxes would be a good step to encourage new investments in private industries.
8. The concept of city clusters developing in to new industrial zones with proper connectivity infrastructure would augur well for future growth.
9. Youth policies should provide for:
 - i. Scouts movements and volunteer social services –
 - ii. Community services/medical camps from college and university students
 - iii. Sports facilities

- iv. Libraries
 - v. Career counseling
 - vi. Value of educated/skilled youth- technical skills training programs for youth from school and college days.
 - vii. Extra-curricular activities
 - viii. Civic living and civilized society for younger generations. Activities like Bazm-e-Adab need to be initiated again in schools and colleges.
 - ix. Taking part in labour activities in nearby factories/industries for some time during their study years
10. Questions raised by the stakeholders related to New Framework for Economic Growth (NFEG) of Pakistan :
- i. Best cotton is produced in Lasbela region of Balochistan, but the cotton mills are being auctioned?
 - ii. Why sustained policies are not being adopted – nationalization verses privatization?
 - iii. Why new dams are not built, why electricity theft is attributed to line losses; what are the reasons behind it?
 - iv. How and why higher classes of society are indulging in electricity theft, why such corruption is being tolerated?
 - v. Law makers are often the law breakers in Pakistan. How would the rule of law prevail in our country?

Prof. Dr. Abdul Hameed Bajoi, Vice Chancellor LUWAMS in his concluding remarks highlighted the following:

1. Our GDP growth compared to Bangladesh, India and other regional countries is at lower side. We have to seriously think of removing hurdles in growth.
2. Good governance, rule of law, effective legislation and better leadership is required.
3. LUAWMS is playing a leading role in the region for youth development.
4. Planning commission, district and provincial government and teachers to collaborate in assistance with elementary college, press and media to further put up their research for growth of our local resources/industries like Marble industry in Lasbela.

In the end Dr. Bajoi thanked the participants for their interest and active participation in the stakeholders' dialogue on economic growth of Pakistan. He said that hopefully the findings/suggestions of the stakeholders would receive due consideration by the concerned departments in Planning Commission for formulation of implementation polices/ frameworks for the NGF.
